Contest Rules:

1. The shooting contest is open to all women and men who are 19 years or older, after July 26, 2024.
2. Shooting contests will be held together for women ("Classic Annie") and men ("Classic Frank"). Prize money is for the overall two winners in each contest.
3. The contest registration fee is \$20.
4. The completed registration form and check should be **mailed by July 10** to AOCF, P.O. Box 1025, Greenville, OH. Bring the form and payment to the registration table at the event. Make checks for \$20 payable to: Annie Oakley Center Foundation.
5. **On-site registration and entry fee collection will be available at the event. Walk-in registrations are welcomed.**

6. Contestants must shoot from a standing position. Reasonable accommodations will be made for individuals with a related disability.
7. All contestants must use the BB guns provided by the Annie Oakley Committee.
8. Shooting will begin at 50 feet and move back at pre-established lengths for each round.
9. Contestants will aim at inflated balloons with a BB gun and attempt to burst the balloon. Contestants will be given two chances to break the balloon target. The balloon must break to advance. The judging committee reserves the right to advance contestants if the balloon is hit by a BB but does not break. This would be considered a broken balloon.
10. **An optional practice session** (contestants shooting one at a time) will begin prior to the event on Friday, July 26 at 4:30 p.m. and end promptly at 5:45 p.m.
11. A cash prize will be awarded to first- and second- place shooting finishers in each contest.
12. The Annie Oakley Center Foundation Shooting Contest Committee reserves the right to amend the rules and procedures as needed. All decisions by this committee will be final.
